Eeyou Mobility Celebrates 3rd Anniversary while building out the Billy-Diamond Highway and Access Roads into the Communities

The Region's Largest Cellular Network is Growing Larger

Chisasibi, QC — November 11, 2024 — Eeyou Mobility, the regionally-owned cell service provider and network coverage leader in Eeyou Istchee and the James Bay region, celebrates its third anniversary with an ever-growing network. Eeyou Mobility service is rapidly expanding along the Billy-Diamond Highway and the key access roads, providing unparalleled voice and broadband coverage, safety and convenience for residents, businesses, and travelers in the region.

This ambitious project has been driven by Eeyou Mobility's own significant investments, and further supported through \$57 million in funding from the governments of Canada and Quebec. Eeyou Mobility's expansion is transformational for the Billy-Diamond Highway, Routes 109, 113, and 167, as well as the access roads to the communities. As Eeyou Mobility enters its fourth year, the mission remains — to bring quality connectivity and digital equity to the communities of Eeyou Istchee and James Bay.

"Three years ago, Eeyou Mobility first launched mobile service in several communities, kicking off the build-out that is now connecting all our communities and soon all our roadways. We are achieving what we set out to do — provide the region with quality mobile services that are on par with or better than those in the south," said Henry Gull, President of Eeyou Mobility. "We're incredibly proud of the progress we've made. Now that service is available in all 14 communities, at km 381, and increasingly along the roadways, completing coverage along all the highways and access roads is the next step to deliver on our mission."

Eeyou Mobility places local expertise at the forefront, creating both connectivity and lasting community impact. By prioritizing local talent and infrastructure, the company has fostered skill development and opportunities for sustainable growth across the region.

"One main achievement that makes me proud to be part of all this is that innovative and valuable work is done by locals. In the end, Eeyou Mobility is made for us and built by us," added Mr. Gull, speaking from company headquarters in Chisasibi.

Along with all 14 communities of the region, Eeyou Mobility service is also available at the popular KM 381 rest stop, and over a dozen new towers have already been constructed. These will soon be turned on to provide expanded coverage along the Billy-Diamond Highway, and around Chisasibi, Matagami, Waswanipi, Lebel-sur-Quévillon, Chapais and Chibougamau. Eeyou Mobility will continue roadway construction at a rapid clip throughout 2025, with a total of 46 towers to be built in this phase of deployment.
